We are looking for a motivated and enthusiastic **postdoctoral fellow** who is interested in developing a measles-virus based broad-spectrum Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine, in collaboration with Michael Mühlebach at the Paul-Ehrlich Institute in Germany. In addition, we are interested in the pathobiology and early events of human HPV infection. The experimental strategies used include molecular, cell biology and immunological tools, gene-transduction, ultracentrifugation, high-resolution microscopy, bio-imaging and mouse genetic tools.
