The Faculty is comprised of 35 world leaders in the field of venous disease. The participants will interact with the renowned faculty and skilled industry representatives, who will all be available at the 20 workstations during the entire three days.

The daily format is morning presentations (35) followed by illustrative clinical problem cases discussed in dialogue with the participants (15). Over 12 hours in the afternoons are dedicated to hands-on workshops.

Regular Registration is £500. For physicians in training and physicians currently resident and working in non-EU Eastern European countries the registration fee is reduced to £300. Attendance is limited to 100 delegates and will be on a first come basis.
